- Motivations for internationalization:
  - Mutual Understanding
    - Intercultural & diversity
    - Humanity
  - Capacity Building
    - Better graduates (employability)
    - Better staff
  - Income Generating Aspects
    - Is internationalization an economic issue?
    - University needs to decide
  - Networking/Partnerships
  - All these should not be separated

- Problems, Constraints and Challenges
  - Financial Issues
    - Allocation in university budget
    - Availability of external funding
  - Language Barriers
    - The need for English Language Programs
  - Brain Drain

- Solving the problems/constraints:
  - Finance:
    - Allocate a part of the budget (make it into a priority)
    - Seek governmental support
    - Policies
  - Language barrier
    - Provide English Language Programs as some kind of a 'bridge'
    - English Language Programs would help in completing studies
    - Policies: university policies
  - Brain Drain:
    - Needs governmental policies (both sides)
